DREXEL UNIVERSITY

The Summit is a new 25-story residential high-rise building developed through a partnership with Drexel University and American Campus Communities(ACC).

The Summit features one level of below grade parking, a ground level of retail, student housing amenities, outdoor courtyard, and 23 levels of student housing apartments. The project provides approximately 1,300 beds for students.

The building features a high efficiency HP system, life safety systems, recirculating DHW

system, pressure zones for high-rise control and mechanical radiant flooring for large expanses of glass in the dining area.

The Summit is the largest building on Drexel's campus and the largest student housing facility in ACC's portfolio.
