SYMPHONY HOUSE

The Symphony House was designed with meticulous detail to the grandeur and romanticism of the 1920's. Rising 31 stories, the building invites guests into a world of extraordinary luxury with breathtaking views of Philadelphia.

This mixed-use tower located at Broad and Pine Street next to the Kimmel Performing Arts Center incorporates 167 residential units, parking for 395 cars, street level retail and a 30,000 SF performing arts venue.

The HVAC system consists of a four-pipe fan coil system with centrifugal chillers and heat derived from the local steam utility. The electrical service is a dual service with double-ended switch gear.
