Two new state-of-the-art facilities required LEED Commissioning to achieve their LEED-NC gold certification levels. The first was the School of Nursing's new Driscoll Hall, which was the 1st building on Villanova's campus to achieve LEED Gold Certification. The second was a new Law School facility. Both buildings offer students the latest advances in technology and provide engaging environments for students and faculty to interact.

Law School

Bala provided fundamental and enhanced building systems commissioning. This 170,000 SF, four story building achieved LEED-NC Gold Certification. The building also includes a 48,000 SF library, occupying an entire wing of the building complete with state-of-the-art technology, high ceilings, and plenty of study areas. There are 15 classrooms and 4 clinical spaces offering students functional work areas, case management technology, and private client interview rooms. The remaining building space includes a commons, cafeteria, and faculty/administration offices.

College of Nursing

Bala provided fundamental and enhanced building systems commissioning for the new 75,000 SF, three story, LEED-NC Gold certified facility. The building includes classrooms, auditoriums, lecture halls, clinical simulation laboratories, and faculty/administrative offices.
